REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

Cap. 39. In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce Export (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Produce Export Regulations, 1953 and 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Agricultural Produce Export Regulations, 1953 to 1954.

2. Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "fees at the rate of three piastres per package per day" (lines 5 and 6) of the words "charges at the rate of three piastres per package per day or part thereof".

3. Regulation 20 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion, immediately after sub-regulation (2), of the following new sub-regulation :—

"(3) Each citrus fruit intended for export shall, unless the Director of Agriculture directs otherwise, be wrapped in paper bearing printed thereon the mark of origin referred to in paragraph (b) of regulation 22."

4. Regulation 22 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraph (b) and by the substitution therefor of the following paragraph :—

"(b) The other end of the case or basket shall be marked with any mark of origin as may be directed from time to time by the Director of Agriculture."
