In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 of the Boats Regulation Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Boats (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Boats Regulations (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. The Second Appendix (relating to Lighterage Charges) to the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein in its proper alphabetical place of the following Item :—
