

No. 381. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.
CAP. 142.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Kato Zodhia, in the District of Nicosia, and approved by the Commissioner are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF KATO ZODHIA UNDER SECTION (9).

In exercise of the powers vested in them by Section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, Cap. 142, the Village Health Commission of Kato Zodhia hereby make the following rules:—

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1. These Rules may be cited as the Village Health (Kato Zodhia) (Amendment) Rules, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Kato Zodhia) Rules 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Kato Zodhia) Rules, 1938 and 1955.

2. Rule 20 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule:—

"Rule 20.—The following fees shall be paid by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in a slaughter-house, that is to say:—

(a) For every bullock, camel, cow or ox	2	0
(b) For every goat, kid, lamb or sheep	1	0
(c) For every swine	2	0

3. Rule 32 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule:—

"Rule 32.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any perishable goods in the market of perishable goods, that is to say:—

	<i>s.</i>	<i>p.</i>
(a) when the value of such goods is under five shillings	—	3
(b) when the value of such goods exceeds five shillings but does not exceed ten shillings	—	6
(c) when the value of such goods exceeds ten shillings but does not exceed twenty shillings	1	0

(2) If the value of such goods exceeds twenty shillings, a fee of six piastres for each additional pound or fraction thereof shall be added to the aforementioned fee of one shilling.

(3) Every such fee shall be paid to the Inspector."

4. Rule 46 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule:—

"Rule 46.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say:—

	<i>s.</i>	<i>p.</i>
(a) For every carcass of sheep or goat or part thereof	1	0
(b) For every carcass of young lamb or kid or part thereof	1	0
(c) For every carcass of ox, camel, cow or bullock or part thereof	2	0

(2) The fees in paragraph (1) of this rule prescribed shall not be payable by any person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, who is a monthly or yearly lessee of any shop, stall or place in the meat market under rule 45 of these Rules."

5. Rule 54 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule:—

"Rule 54.—(1) The following fee shall be paid by the owner of or the person exposing for sale any carcass of swine or fresh pork in the pork market, that is to say, for every carcass of swine or part thereof or portion of fresh pork 2s.

(2) Every such fee shall be paid to the Inspector."
