And whereas by a notice published under Notification No. 460 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 22nd July, 1954, it was declared that the Bombardment Range Area declared under the principal notice shall continue to be a Bombardment Range Area for the purposes of the Law for a further period of twelve months as from the 27th day of July, 1954;

And whereas it is desirable to prolong the date of the operation of the principal notice for a further period expiring on the 31st day of May, 1956:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to declare that the Bombardment Range Area declared under the principal notice shall continue to be a Bombardment Range Area for the purposes of the Law for a further period expiring on the 31st day of May, 1956.
