**No. 484. THE CURFEWS LAW, 1955.**

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Curfews Law, 1955, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Limassol District) Order, 1955.
2. Until further notice no person within the area of AGROS Village shall be out of doors between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. except under the written authority of the Commissioner of Limassol or the Superintendent of Police or Assistant Superintendent of Police of Limassol :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of August, 1955.
