## THE INLAND TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE LAW, 1954.

APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE AUTHORITY AND DESIGNATION OF  
CHAIRMAN UNDER SECTION 5 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 5 (1) of the Inland Telecommunications Service Law, 1954, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to appoint Mr. John Arthur Smale, C.B.E., to be a member of the Cyprus Inland Telecommunications Authority and to designate him to be Chairman thereof from the 4th September, 1955, *vice* Mr. David Athelstane Percival whose appointment as Chairman of the said Authority is hereby terminated as from that date.

## THE WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY LAWS, 1952 AND 1955.

## ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by the proviso to sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Wireless Telegraphy Laws, 1952 and 1955, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to order as follows:— 7 of 1952  
37 of 1955.

1. This Order may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Government Departments) (Exemption) Order, 1955.

2. The establishment, installation, use and maintenance by any Department of the Government of stations for wireless telegraphy and wireless telegraphy apparatus are hereby exempted from the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Wireless Telegraphy Laws, 1952 and 1955.

## THE RURAL CONSTABLES LAW.

## CAP. 267 AND LAW 46 OF 1954.

## ORDER UNDER SECTION 5 (3).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 5 (3) of the Rural Constables Law, the Acting Governor has been pleased to order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Rural Constables (Minimum Salary) Order, 1955.

2. From and after the 1st day of January, 1956, the monthly salary to be paid to every rural constable or temporary rural constable shall not be less than £13:

Provided that if a rural constable or temporary rural constable is required to keep a horse his monthly salary shall not be less than £14.

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 3.

**No. 526. THE EXCHANGE CONTROL LAWS, 1952 AND 1954.**

ORDER MADE BY THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY, UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Exchange Control Laws, 1952 and 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), I, the Financial Secretary, hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Exchange Control (Specified Currency) (Amendment) Order, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Exchange Control (Specified Currency) Order, 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Exchange Control (Specified Currency) Orders, 1954 and 1955.

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by inserting in the Schedule thereto under the words "Indo-Chinese Piastres" the words "Italian lire".

3. This Order shall be deemed to have been made and to have come into force on the 22nd day of August, 1955.
