NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

JOHN HARDING,

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to establish and operate a Police training camp together with such buildings, erections, structures and other installations as may be necessary for and within the Athalassa area in the District of Nicosia, the cost whereof is to be borne by the Government of Cyprus :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby declare the establishment and operation of the Police training camp to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby entrust the Director of Public Works, or in his absence the person acting for the time being as Deputy Director of Public Works, with the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking.

No. 723. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.

*Authority to the Village Health Commission of Gaidhouras
(Famagusta District) to contract a loan.*

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 10 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Governor's Deputy, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. The Village Health Commission of Gaidhouras (Famagusta District) (hereinafter referred to as "the Village Health Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter
