**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)  
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 12) 1956.**

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER REGULATION 41 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 41 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 12) 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Publication of Casualties) Order, 1956.
2. The publication in the Colony—
  - (a) of the name, rank, indication of rank or unit of any member of Her Majesty's Forces or of the Cyprus Police Force ;
  - (b) of the name and particulars of any expatriate officer in the service of the Crown,

who has been killed or injured in the Colony, is hereby prohibited until such particulars have been released for publication by the Public Relations Department.

3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Order shall be liable to the penalties specified in Regulation 41 (2) and 75 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 12) 1956.
