In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52B of the Police Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Cyprus Police Association (Amendment) Rules, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Police Association Rules, 1953 and 1954 (as set out in the Schedule to Law 24 of 1953 and as amended by the Police Association (Amendment) Rules, 1954, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") and the principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Cyprus Police Association Rules, 1953 to 1956.

2. Rule 4 of the principal Rules (as set out in the Schedule to Law 24 of 1953) is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor :—

"4. The Committee shall consist of one member for each Division elected by members of the Force for the rank in question belonging to that Division. For the purposes of these Rules the following shall be deemed to constitute the Divisions :—

- (a) Nicosia, Limassol, Famagusta, Larnaca, Paphos, Kyrenia and Lefka Divisions.
- (b) Headquarters Division.
- (c) Training School Division.
- (d) Mobile Reserve Division."

3. Rule 6 of the principal Rules (as set out in the Schedule to Law 24 of 1953) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the word "annually" in the first line and by the substitution therefor of the word "biennially".

4. Rule 15 of the principal Rules (as set out in the Schedule to Law 24 of 1953) is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following proviso :—

"Provided that a Divisional Joint Inspectors, Sergeants and Constables Committee, from time to time and with the approval of the Divisional Officer, may—

- (a) discuss any matter which is within the powers given to them by these Rules ; and
- (b) under the chairmanship of a gazetted officer discuss and make recommendations affecting welfare and sport within such Division and may, for this purpose, co-opt not more than two members of the Force of the same Division."
