THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.

LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th October, 1955, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia and Kyrenia District No. 3) Order, 1956.

2. No person within the village boundaries of Morphou shall be out of doors on the dates and during the hours prescribed in the Schedule hereto except under the written authority of the Assistant Commissioner of Lefka or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 7th day of March, 1956.

SCHEDULE.

Between the hours of 6.30 p.m. on Wednesday the 7th March, 1956, and 7.30 a.m. on Thursday the 8th March, 1956.
