**No. 212. THE MAINTENANCE ORDERS (FACILITIES FOR  
ENFORCEMENT) LAW.**  
CAP. 22.

PROCLAMATION UNDER SECTION 11.

Whereas by section 11 of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Law it is provided that where the Governor is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the Legislature of any British possession or any territory under Her Majesty's protection for the enforcement within such possession or territory of maintenance orders made by Courts in Cyprus, the Governor may by proclamation extend the said Law to such possession or territory :

And whereas I am satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the Governor in Council of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia for the enforcement within State of Victoria of maintenance orders made by Courts in Cyprus :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the said section 11 of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Law, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, the Governor, do hereby order and proclaim that the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Law shall extend to the State of Victoria as from the 21st day of December, 1955.
