THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.
LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th October, 1955, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Limassol District No. 5) Order, 1956.

2. No person within the Municipal boundaries of the town of Limassol shall be out of doors on the dates and during the hours prescribed in the Schedule hereto except under the written authority of the Commissioner of Limassol, or the Senior Superintendent of Police, Limassol :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of March, 1956.

Between the hours of 6 a.m. on Friday the 16th March, 1956, and 5 a.m. on Saturday the 17th March, 1956.
