THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 6) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 40.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 40 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 6) 1956, I, William Frederick Martin Clemens, Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, do hereby order that all establishments owned by Greek Cypriots, and situated within the Municipal limits of Nicosia and the village areas of Strovolos, Engomi, Ayios Dhometios, Trakhonas, Omorphita, Beuyuk Kaimakli and Palouriotissa shall be closed, and shall remain closed between the hours of 7 a.m. on the 18th April, 1956, and 9 a.m. on the 24th April, 1956, inclusive:

Provided that hotels may remain open for the purposes of catering for residents staying therein.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 4) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 4) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I give notice that in the interests of public order and safety I have taken possession until further notice of the land specified in the Schedule hereto.

2. The use of the said land by Her Majesty's Forces for military and security purposes is hereby authorised.

3. The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for such military purposes.

4. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this order shall remain in force.

That part of plot 615 of the Government Survey Plan, Sheet XXXIII.12. 6.IV. Block D, Ayios Nikolaos Quarter, Varosha, delineated and shown in red on the plan dated 2nd April, 1956, and signed by the Commissioner, Famagusta.
