THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 5) 1956.

ORDER UNDER REGULATION 62A.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 62A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1956, I, the Commissioner of Famagusta, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibition of Underwater swimming (Famagusta District No. 1) Order, 1956.
2. No person shall swim underwater with the aid of any artificial breathing apparatus within the area specified in the Schedule hereto, except under the written authority of the Port Superintendent, Famagusta.

SCHEDULE.

The Port limits of Famagusta as defined in Part I of the Schedule to the Customs Management (Ports, Aerodromes and Shipping Places) Order, 1954.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 5) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 34 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor under paragraph 34 (1) (b) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 807 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 22nd December, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Paphos, hereby prohibit the use of motor cycles and bicycles within the municipal limits of Paphos, between the hours of 6.30 p.m. and 4 a.m. as from 6.30 p.m. on Wednesday, the 11th April, 1956, until further notice.
