**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 6) 1956.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 34 (1) (b). *Revised*

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor under paragraph 34 (1) (b) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 6) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 807, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 27th December, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Nicosia, hereby prohibit the use of all motor vehicles within the Municipal limits of Nicosia and the village areas of Strovolos, Engomi, Ayios Dhometios, Trakhonas, Omorphita, Beuyuk Kaimakli and Palouriotissa, between the hours of 6.30 p.m. and 4.00 a.m. as from 6.30 p.m. on Wednesday the 18th April, 1956, until 4 a.m. on Wednesday 25th April, 1956.

This Order is in addition to, and not in derogation of, the order published under Notification No. 156, in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 6th March, 1956.

The Order published under Notification No. 312 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 19th April, 1956, is hereby revoked.
