

No. 477. THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW.

CAP. 92 AND LAW 16 OF 1954.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3(1) of the Foreshore Protection Law, I do hereby absolutely prohibit :—

- (a) the removal of stones, shingle, gravel and sand or other substance from all parts of the foreshore lying within the area described in the Schedule hereto ;
- (b) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

Karavostasi and Pendayia.

The foreshore commences at a point on the sea-shore, which point is due north of the north-eastern corner of plot No. 403 of Block "A" Karavostasi village, locality "Varka" and proceeds in a north-easterly direction along the high-water mark for a distance of $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles or thereabouts to the most northern point of plot No. 10 of the Government Survey Plan No. XIX.51, Pendayia village, and includes any land within a distance of fifty yards of the said high-water mark throughout its length. The said foreshore is more particularly defined as the area coloured yellow on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1649, a copy of which is available for inspection at the office of the Commissioner, Nicosia and Kyrenia, at Lefka.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 2.
