DELEGATION OF GOVERNOR'S POWERS UNDER SECTION 2A.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2A of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and of every other power enabling me in that behalf, I, the Governor, do hereby delegate to the Commissioner and Assistant Commissioners of each District, in respect of the areas of their respective Districts, all the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955.

Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th October, 1955, is hereby revoked.

**No. 667. THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL,**  
**1939 AND 1956.**

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Amendment of Law 40 of 1955) (No. 2) Regulations, 1956.
2. During the continuance in force of these Regulations, section 2 of the Criminal Procedure (Temporary Provisions) Law, 1955 (No. 40 of 1955) shall be read and construed as if the said section were amended by the substitution for the words "the Chief Justice or a Judge of the Supreme Court" occurring in the fifth line thereof, of the words "the Chief Justice, a Judge of the Supreme Court or a Judge of the Special Court".

Made at Nicosia, this 14th day of July, 1956.
