NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to Notification No. 466 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 7th June, 1956, notice is hereby given that the following land is required by the Governor for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

All that area of privately owned land, with everything standing thereon, situated at Kokkini Trimithia village, comprising 1,600 sq. ft. or thereabouts, forming parts of plots Nos. 378/1 and 380 of the Government Survey Plan No. XX.56, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Director of Water Development and dated the 20th July, 1956.
