**THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL,
1939 AND 1956.**

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Suspension of the Operation of the Port Workers (Regulation of Employment) Laws, 1952 and 1954) Regulations, 1956.

2. The provisions of the Port Workers (Regulation of Employment) Laws, 1952 and 1954, and of any Law amending or substituted for the same, and the provisions of the Port Workers (Regulation of Employment) Regulations, 1952 to 1954, and of any Regulations amending or substituted for the same, shall not apply to the employment of members of Her Majesty's Forces or of a visiting force in connection with the loading, unloading, movement or storage of operational cargo, or on work in connection with the preparation of ships, aircraft or other vessels for the receipt or discharge of operational cargo.

3. For the purposes of these Regulations—

“operational cargo” means goods which any officer of Her Majesty's Forces or of a visiting force declares, and the Superintendent of the Port is satisfied, are required for use by Her Majesty's Forces or by a visiting force and are of a nature which, on grounds of security, should be loaded, unloaded, or otherwise handled, by members of Her Majesty's Forces or of a visiting force;

“Superintendent of the Port” has the same meaning as in the Port Regulation Law;

“visiting force” has the meaning assigned to it by section 12 (1) of the Visiting Forces Act, 1952, as extended to the Colony by the Visiting Forces Act (Application to Colonies) Order, 1954, and as read together with the Visiting Forces (Designation) Order, 1954, the Visiting Forces (Designation) (Colonies) Order, 1954, and the Visiting Forces (Designation) (Colonies) (Amendment) Order, 1956.
