THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

JOHN HARDING, Governor.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations:-

Insertion of the principal Regulations.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) (Amendment No. 12) Regulations, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 11) 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 12) 1956.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion new Regula- therein, immediately after Regulation 43, of the following new Regulation:

" Prohibition of publication of certain photographs, etc.

43A. (1) No person shall make, print, publish, sell or expose for sale, any photograph, or any other reproduction whatsoever, of any person who has been convicted of an offence against Regulation 52 of these Regulations.

(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Regulation shall be guilty of an offence against these Regulations."
