Whereas by Notification published under No. 986 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 18th October, 1956, the Governor declared under sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law the construction of a Government Central Store to be an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia by a notice published under Notification No. 1184 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 29th November, 1956, gave particulars of the properties (hereinafter referred to as "the properties") required in connection with the aforesaid undertaking;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, the Governor hereby sanctions the acquisition of the properties under the provisions of the said Law.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 19 of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law, His Excellency the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Streets and Buildings (Amendment) Regulations, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Streets and Buildings Regulations (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Part II of the Appendix to the principal Regulations (as set out in regulation 3 of the Streets and Buildings (Amendment) Regulations, 1956) is hereby amended by the substitution for the figures £0.400 appearing against item (i) under the word "Limassol" of the figures £0.500.
