Notice under Regulation 20 (b).

Packing Specifications for Perishables.

Gazette: 20. 1.1956.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 20 (b) of the Suppl. No. 3: Agricultural Produce (Export) Regulations, 1956, I, the Director of Commerce and Industry, do hereby direct as follows:-

PART I.—CITRUS FRUIT.

1. Citrus fruit of any type intended for export to any destination shall not be packed except in one of the following manners:-

(i) In new wooden cases conforming with the provisions of Regulations 5 and 40 of the Regulations, made of wood of the following thicknesses :-

> End and centre partitions ... 16 mm. Top and bottom staves ... 7 mm. . . Side Staves 8 mm; or

(ii) In cartons.
