THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 11th December, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 13th December, 1956, under Notification No. 1224 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the village areas of Kalopsidha, Makrasyka and Athna in the Famagusta District and Xylotymbou and Pyla in the Larnaca District (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Gazette: Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services Supplement (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by No. 2A: virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1956), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorisation for using the land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the 11th June, 1957, and the Order is so extended accordingly.
