

And whereas by virtue of Notifications Nos. 642 and 1284 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of the 12th July, 1956 and 28th December, 1956 respectively, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 27th July, 1957 ;

And whereas the Governor's Deputy is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1956) the Governor's Deputy has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorization for using the land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the 28th July, 1957 and the Order is so extended accordingly.

**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

**REVOCATION OF ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE
REGULATION 64.**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force in consequence of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1956), the Governor's Deputy hereby revokes the Order made by His Excellency the Governor under Defence Regulation 64 and published under Notification No. 1076 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 15th November, 1956 (as amended by Notification No. 1197 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 6th December, 1956 and as extended by Notification No. 74 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 31st January, 1957) without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
