In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Post Office Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Air Mail Rates of Postage) Orders, 1955 and 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rates of Postage) Orders, 1955 to 1957.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to the countries shown in the Schedule hereto and the substitution therefor of the entries relating to the same countries set out in the Schedule hereto.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 15th day of August, 1957.
