NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17 (7).

With reference to the notice published under No. 1288 in the *Gazette* of 17th November, 1955, as amended by notice No. 142 published in the *Gazette* of 31st January, 1957, it is hereby notified for general information that, after considering the plans and specifications concerning the streets enumerated under column (1) of the Schedule hereto, no objections having been made, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to approve the plans and specifications concerning the said streets to the extent shown under column (2) of the Schedule hereto.

2. The plans and specifications in respect of the streets set out in the Schedule hereto shall, subject to the conditions shown under column (2) of the Schedule, be binding on the Municipal Council of Nicosia and upon all owners affected.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE IMPROVEMENT BOARD OF YIALOUSA.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Improvement Board of Yialousa hereby make the following bye-laws:—

These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yialousa (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yialousa Bye-laws, 1951 and 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yialousa Bye-laws, 1951 to 1957.

2. The Third Appendix to the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words and figures "180 to 184 (both inclusive)" and the substitution therefor of the figure "180".

The above bye-laws have been approved by the Acting Administrative Secretary.
