THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT) LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.

Bye-laws made by the Improvement Board of Yialousa.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Improvement Board of Yialousa hereby make the following bye-laws:—

- 1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yialousa (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yialousa Bye-laws, 1951 and 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yialousa Bye-laws, 1951 to 1957.
- 2. The Third Appendix to the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words and figures "180 to 184 (both inclusive)" and the substitution therefor of the figure "180".
