ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2957

MADE UNDER SECTION 60 (d).

Whereas by the Unlawful Association (E.O.K.A.) Order, 1955, which was published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 15th September, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Order"), the organization commonly known as "E.O.K.A." ("National Organisation of Cypriot Combatants") was declared, under paragraph (d) of section 60 of the Criminal Code, to be used for the promotion of disorder and of the spread of sedition within the Colony and to be proscribed within the Colony :

And whereas it is provided, *inter alia*, under the said paragraph (d) of section 60 of the Criminal Code that any such order made under the said paragraph shall remain in force for a period of twelve months from the date of its publication in the *Gazette* and no longer unless renewed for such further period or periods, not exceeding twelve months at any one time, as the Governor-in-Council may direct by order published in the *Gazette* ;

And whereas the said Order was renewed for a period of twelve months as from the 15th September, 1956 ;

And whereas it is considered desirable to renew the said Order for a further period of twelve months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (d) of section 60 of the Criminal Code, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Unlawful Association (E.O.K.A.) (Renewal) Order, 1957.

2. The Unlawful Association (E.O.K.A.) Order, 1955, is hereby renewed for a further period of twelve months as from the 15th September, 1957.

No. 854. THE DETENTION OF PERSONS LAWS, 1955.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2959

MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by the proviso to section 5 of the Detention of Persons Laws, 1955, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Detention of Persons (Continuance) (No. 2) Order, 1957.

2. The Detention of Persons Laws, 1955, shall continue in operation for a period of six months from the 1st day of November, 1957, that is until the 30th day of April, 1958, and shall then expire unless continued in force for any further period or periods of six months by the Governor-in-Council, by Order published in the *Gazette*, under the provisions of the proviso to section 5 of the said Laws.

No. 855. THE SPECIAL COURT LAWS, 1955 TO (No. 2) 1956.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2960

MADE UNDER SECTION 18.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by the proviso to section 18 of the Special Court Laws, 1955 to (No. 2) 1956, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Special Court (Continuance) (No. 2) Order, 1957.

2. The Special Court Laws, 1955 to (No. 2) 1956, shall continue in operation for a period of six months from the 1st day of November, 1957, that is until the 30th day of April, 1958, and shall then expire unless continued in force for any further period or periods of six months by the Governor-in-Council, by Order published in the *Gazette*, under the provisions of the proviso to section 18 of the said Laws.
