THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.
LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District No. 6) Order, 1957.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the Schedule hereto shall be out of doors as from 10.30 hours on 25th of January, 1957, until further notice, except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any person who is—

- (a) not a Greek Cypriot male born on or after 1st January, 1936 ;
- (b) a Government servant ;
- (c) a pupil attending an elementary school.

This Order is in addition to and not in derogation of the Order dated 5th day of November, 1956, published as Notification No. 1061 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 8th November, 1956, as amended by Notification No. 19 dated 24th December, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 3rd January, 1957, and Order dated 22nd day of January, 1957.

SCHEDULE.

The Municipal limits of Nicosia and the village areas of Strovolos, Engomi, Ayios Dhometios, Trakhonas, Omorphita, Beuyuk Kaimakli and Palouriotissa.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Larnaca District No. 18) Order, 1956.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Larnaca, or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 14th day of October, 1956.
