THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Extension of Period of Duration of Municipal Councils) Regulations, 1958.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Municipal Corporations Law (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") the period of duration of every council of a municipal corporation, as extended by the Emergency Powers (Extension of Period of Duration of Municipal Councils) Regulations, 1956, for a period of one year from the date on which such period of duration would otherwise have expired, is hereby extended for a further period of one year from the date on which such period of duration would have expired save for the provisions of these Regulations, and the operation of those provisions of the Law which relate to the election of councillors is hereby suspended accordingly.

3. Section 11 of the Law shall accordingly be read and construed as if for the words "five years", occurring in line 1 thereof, and in line 3 of paragraph (b) of the proviso thereto (as amended by the Emergency Powers (Extension of Period of Duration of Municipal Councils) Regulations, 1956) there were substituted the words "six years".
