**No. 368. THE ASSEMBLIES AND PROCESSIONS LAW.**  
(LAW No. 7 OF 1958.)

ORDER UNDER PARAGRAPH (a) OF SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 5.

HUGH FOOT,  
Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the Assemblies and Processions Law, I, the Governor, hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Assemblies and Processions (Prohibition) (Places not being Public Places) Order, 1958.
2. In this Order "assembly" means any celebration, ceremony or any public gathering whatsoever, not being exempted from the operation of the Assemblies and Processions Law by sub-section (1) of section 9 thereof, and includes any theatrical or cinematograph performance, but does not include . . . . .
3. The holding of any assembly or procession in any place, not being a public place, in any part of the Colony is hereby prohibited.
