**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 27th February, 1956 and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 18th March, 1956 under Notification No. 153 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the village of Perivolia, (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months ;

And whereas by virtue of Notifications Nos. 825, 122 and 743 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of the 30th August, 1956, 14th February 1957 and 1st August 1957 respectively, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 26th February, 1958 ;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :
