THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 2) 1958.

## ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 38.

I, the Assistant Commissioner of Kyrenia, in exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (1) of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 2) 1958, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Protected Areas (Kyrenia District)

(No. 2) Order, 1958.

2. The area specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a protected area for the purpose of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 2) 1958.

3. This Order shall come into force at 6 a.m. on Sunday, 20th July, 1958,

and shall remain in force until 11 a.m. on the same date.

THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.

LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District No. 22) Order, 1958.
- 2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive

Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 6th day of July, 1958.

The village areas of Potamos Tou Kambou, Galini and Loutros.

From 1930 hours on 6th July till 1200 on 7th July, 1958.
