1. This Order may be cited as the Landing Charges (Amendment) Order, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Landing Charges Order, 1958 (hereinafter referred to as 'the principal Order').

2. Paragraph 5 of the principal Order is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor :—

“5. In the case of goods consigned to Cyprus which are transhipped en route, fifty per centum of the agents' fee payable under paragraph 3 or 4 of this Order shall be paid by the agent of the ship landing such goods to the agent in Cyprus of the ship from which such goods were transhipped.”
