THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.

LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Larnaca District) (No. 20) Order, 1958.

2. No Greek Cypriot male or female born between the 1st January, 1932, and the 1st January, 1944, both dates inclusive, shall be out of doors within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto, between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto, except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Larnaca or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to :—

- (a) any member of the Executive Council ;
- (b) any member of Her Majesty's Forces or of the Cyprus Police Force (which term for the purposes of this Order includes the Auxiliary Police Force and the Police Fire Service) and any Special Constable on duty as such ;
- (c) any person holding a summons to appear before a Special Court, established under the Special Court Laws, 1955 to 1957, when proceeding to and from the Court in accordance with such summons ;
- (d) any advocate in possession of a certificate issued by a Justice of the Special Court or by the Registrar of the Special Court, Nicosia, that he is briefed to appear in the Special Court on a specified date when such advocate is proceeding to and from such Court on such date.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 10th day of November, 1958.

4. The Curfews (Larnaca District) (No. 18) Order, 1958, dated the 16th day of October, 1958, is hereby revoked.

The Municipal limits of Larnaca.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

From 0700 to 0800 and from 1600 to 1700 hours daily on and after the 10th November, 1958, until further notice.
