MADE UNDER SECTION 4.

Cap. 254 In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Municipal Motor Omnibuses Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Municipal Motor Omnibuses (Nicosia Municipality) Order, 1959.

2. The total number of omnibuses which may be licensed by the municipal council of the municipal corporation of Nicosia to ply for hire at any one time within the municipal limits of the said corporation shall not exceed forty.

3. The Order in Council bearing the number 1405 and published under Public Instrument No. 135 of 1951 is hereby revoked.

No. 176. THE POST OFFICE LAW.
(CAP. 281)

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3067

MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

Cap. 281. In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 7 of the Post
 44 of 1953. Office Law, the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council makes the Order following :

Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Postage Rates) Order, 1959
 and shall take effect from the 1st day of April, 1959.

Postal Rates. 2. The rates of postage and charges set out in the Schedule to this Order
 shall be charged by the Postmaster General on all postal packets coming out
 or delivered for conveyance by post.

Repeal. 3. The Post Office (Rates of Postage and Postal Charges) Order, 1955
 contained in Public Instrument No. 438 of 1955 as amended by Public
 Instrument No. 785 of 1956 and Public Instrument No. 896 of 1957 is
 hereby revoked.

THE CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT LAWS, 1954 TO 1959.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3068

MADE UNDER SECTION 42.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 42 of the Customs Management Laws, 1954 to 1959, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Management (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) (Amendment) Order, 1959, and shall be read as one with the Customs Management (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Order, 1958, as from time to time amended (hereinafter referred to as " the principal Order ") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Customs Management (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Orders, 1958 and 1959.

2. The Third Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following further item to be numbered " 5 " :—

" 5. Appliances capable of use for filling shot gun cartridges."
