THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) REGULATIONS, 1956.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Regulations 20 (*h*) and 53 (2) of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Regulations, 1956, the Director of Commerce and Industry makes declarations in manner following:—

- (i) grapes of the 1959 crop intended for export as table grapes shall be required before being harvested to be inspected at the place of growth by an inspector; and
- (ii) the minimum requirements of maturity of sultana grapes shall be 9 degrees Beaumé except where in the opinion of the inspector other factors affect maturity.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL  
CORPORATION OF PAPHOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Law, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Paphos hereby make the following Bye-laws:—

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Paphos Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1959, and shall be read as one with the Paphos Municipal Bye-laws, 1943 to 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these Bye-laws may together be cited as the Paphos Municipal Bye-laws, 1943 to 1959.

2. Paragraph (1) of Bye-law 92 of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the Paphos Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1953) is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:—

"(1) The area situated within the Municipal limits, being the property of Mr. Spetseropoulos G. and lying between Theodoros Kolokotronis Street and George Spetseropoulos premises on Neophytos Nicolaides Street; and the area situated within the Municipal limits, being the property of Maroulla, Elli, Angeliki and Alexandra Neokleous on the right-hand side of Limassol Street near the bridge immediately after the Commissioner's House, are hereby provided as public fair markets during the days or time that any fair is being held, within the Municipal limits".

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor.
