(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by the Orders dated as shown in the first column of the Schedule hereto and published as Public Instruments as shown in the second column of the said Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the Orders"), the Governor authorized the use of the land and property specified in the Orders subject to the restrictions and conditions therein contained for military purposes during periods of six months ;

And whereas the Orders were extended from time to time by the Public Instruments shown in the third column of the Schedule ;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land and property should continue to be used for military purposes for further periods :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Defence Regulation 64 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Laws, 1958 and 1959, His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use of the land and property specified in the Orders and subject to the restrictions and conditions therein contained for the further periods shown in the fourth column of the Schedule hereto.

(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.
