TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO THE DEVELOPMENT A.D. 1925. AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE SILKWORM INDUSTRY. 1 of 1925.

BE it enacted:

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Silkworm Industry short title. Protection (Amendment) Law, 1925, and shall be read as one with the Silkworm Industry Protection Law, 1922, and the said Law and this Law may together be cited as the Silkworm Industry Protection Laws, 1922 and 1925.
- 2. It shall not be lawful for any company, corporation, No filature persons or person whatsoever to instal, erect, establish, to be established maintain or use in the Island of Cyprus any filature for without the the manufacture of silk without having previously obticense of the High Comtained from the High Commissioner a license in that missioner. behalf to be granted on such terms and conditions as the High Commissioner may prescribe.

Provided always that this Law shall not apply to any hand-reeling apparatus in common use in Cyprus.

This Law was pullished in the Cyprus Gazette No. 1678 of the 20th February, 1925.
