THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 31 OF 1948.

A LAW TO APPROPRIATE A SUM NOT EXCEEDING THREE MILLION, NINE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED AND FIFTY-ONE POUNDS TO THE SERVICE OF THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDING THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FORTY-EIGHT.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for such Preamble.
expenses of the Government of Cyprus for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, 1948, as are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law, Short title. 1948.

Appropriation of

2. In addition to the sums already lawfully appropriated to the service of the King or which may be hereafter lawfully appropriated thereto, there shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1948, out of the revenue and other funds of the Colony, any sum not exceeding the sum of Three Million, Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven Thousand, Six Hundred and Fifty-One Pounds for defraying the charge of the Government of Cyprus for such period.

3. A sum not exceeding the amount set down under each head in the Schedule hereto may be issued and spent in respect of the Establishment or Service specified and referred to therein.

4. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1948.

A LAW FURTHER TO AMEND THE GOATS LAWS, 1913 TO 1937.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Goats (Amendment) Short title.
Law, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Goats Laws, 1913 to 1937 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Goats Laws, 1913 to 1948.
