THE PROPERTY OF HIS MAJESTY (THEFT AND

Officer Administering the Government.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering
the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the
Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Amendment Law, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Laws, 1946 and 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Laws, 1946 to 1948.

2. Section 4 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the deletion therefrom of the figure “1948.” and the substitution therefor of the figure “1949.”;

(b) by the insertion therein of the following proviso:—

“Provided that the Governor in Council may, by an order to be published in the *Gazette*, continue the operation of this Law or such part thereof as may be specified in the order, for any further period or periods of twelve months.”
