THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 12 OF 1956.

A LAW TO APPROPRIATE A SUM NOT EXCEEDING SIXTEEN MILLION, SEVEN HUNDRED AND FOUR THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-ONE POUNDS TO THE SERVICE OF THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDING THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SIX.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for such Preamble.
expenses of the Government of Cyprus for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, 1956, as are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law, 1956. Short title.

Appropriation of

2. In addition to the sums already lawfully appropriated to the service of the Queen or which may be hereafter lawfully appropriated thereto, there shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1956, out of the revenue and other funds of the Colony, any sum not exceeding the sum of Twelve Million, Eighty-Eight Thousand and Three Hundred and Thirty-Nine Pounds for defraying the charge of the Government of Cyprus for such period as set out in columns (3) and (4) of the Schedule and there shall be issued also and applied to the service of the twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1956, out of the Development Fund of the Colony any sum not exceeding the sum of Four Million, Six Hundred and Sixteen Thousand and Twelve Pounds for defraying the charge of the Government of Cyprus for such period as set out in column (5) of the Schedule.

Appropriation of

3. A sum not exceeding the amount set down under each head in the Schedule may be issued and spent in respect of the Establishment or Service specified and referred to therein.

Date of coming into operation.

4. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1956.
